SCHEDULE ON ARRIVAL

Registration is from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. on Sunday, July 19 in the first floor lounge of Fraser Hall (building 03 on the map). You may park in the lot behind Fraser Hall until you receive your parking pass. Refreshments will be served at registration. There will be an "Icebreaker" musical event at 4 p.m., dinner will follow at 5:30 and orientation will begin at 6:30. Day students should arrive by 3:30 p.m.

HOW TO GET THERE

From Downtown Vancouver AND From the Horseshoe Bay Ferry Terminal:

Follow Highway 1 East to Exit 66 (approx. 45 mins from downtown; 75 mins from the ferry terminal). Take Exit 66 (232nd St.) south and follow the main road for about three kilometers. At the T-junction turn right onto Glover Road. TWU is about one kilometer further, on the right.

From the Tsawwassen Ferry Terminal (in Delta):

Follow Highway 17 for several kilometers until you come to a pedestrian overpass at Ladner Trunk Road (Highway 10). Turn right and drive for 30 to 40 minutes along Highway 10 until you reach Langley and pass 200th St. and Willowbrook Mall (on your left) and McDonalds on your right. Cross the train tracks and immediately turn left onto Glover Road. Trinity Western University is several kilometers along the road, on your right.

From Vancouver International Airport (in Richmond):

Head east along Grant McConachie Way (the main road leading to and from the terminal) and follow the signs for Highway 99 to Seattle. Drive south on Highway 99 about 20 minutes until you get to the exit for Highway 10 (the first exit after the Highway 17 exit). Proceed east along Highway 10 for 20 to 30 minutes, until you reach Langley and pass 200th St. and Willowbrook Mall (on your left) and McDonalds on your right. Cross the train tracks and immediately turn left onto Glover Road. Trinity Western University is several kilometers along the road, on your right.

WHAT TO BRING

In addition to your instrument, music stand, pencil and personal effects, you may find it useful to bring bottled water (although the tap water at TWU has been improved), ear plugs (the train goes by at night), a fan (TWU can get very hot in July), an alarm clock, a coffee mug, a notebook, reading lamp, flashlight, wind clips or clothes pins. Bedding and towels are supplied, but you may want to bring your own towels and an extra blanket or pillow.
