Definitions

Scholarship: Waiver of all or part of the *tuition* portion of the Summer Music Camp (SMC) registration fee.

Bursary: Waiver of all or part of the SMC registration fee for reasons of financial hardship.

Criteria Used for Awarding Scholarships and Bursaries

- Awards will be made to amateur musicians only.
- Priority will be given to students in a post-secondary music program, other students in full-time education, and individuals who study with a professional musician.
- Further consideration will be given to musicians whose voices/instruments are essential for performing the planned SMC repertoire. Other applications will also be judged on their potential benefit to the musical balance of the SMC.
- Bursaries will be awarded on the basis of financial need, coupled with the above considerations.
