Meals

Enjoy a variety of delicious meals in our dining facilities located in the Reimer Student Centre. Be sure to bring your meal wrist band with you to each meal. Our cafeteria is open for "cash sales" from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (weekdays), 8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (weekends)

Recreation

Take time to enjoy the natural beauty of our campus. Many guests enjoy a leisurely walk on the fitness trail that encircles the campus. If you wish to use our sports equipment, check with Conference Centre for times and availability.

Linen Exchange

We will enter your room between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to exchange towels mid-week if your stay is six days or longer.

Internet hook-up

Every bedroom has a "live" phone (analog) jack for you to plug in your lap-top. Please dial "9" and then the local phone number for your Internet Provider. Alternatively you may pay \$10 for a wireless internet connection code. Sign on, then pay by credit card.

Campus safety

To ensure your safety all residence buildings will be locked between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Campus Safety Personnel will be on duty twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. In an emergency, if you need to contact Campus Safety, go to the nearest Pay Phone; pick up the receiver and press the button marked "Security". This will connect you directly to Campus Safety.

Parking

Parking Passes should be displayed on the dash of your car. If you have not received a parking pass from your Conference group, please contact your Conference organizer or drop by the Conference Centre Office in Fraser Hall for a Parking Pass. Note that bicycles are not allowed inside any buildings, including in your room.

Laundry

Coin-operated laundry machines are provided for your use on the main floor of Fraser Hall. The washing machine and dryer each require \$1.00 (a Loonie). Change is available from the change dispensers in the Reimer Student Centre.

Conference centre

The Conference Centre Office is located on the main floor of Fraser Hall. Office hours are Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. During business hours, call 604-513-2002 to reach the Conference Office, or dial local 2002 from an on-campus phone. After business hours, call 604-613-8017 to reach Conference Staff. Our staff on duty will respond promptly.

Telephones

On-campus phones are located in the Douglas Hall Lobby, in the Fraser Hall Lobby, and the Reimer Student Centre Lobby. There are no pay phones on campus. To make outgoing calls using the on-campus phones, you must buy a calling card from the bookstore in the Reimer Student Centre. Any calls for Conference guests that come to the Conference Centre Office will be relayed to your Conference Group Leader.

Mail centre

The Mail Centre is located in Reimer Student Centre, near the Atrium. Stamp booklets (both Canadian and U.S.) can be purchased there. The Mail Centre is open Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. Outgoing mail is picked up at 9:00 a.m. Monday through Friday at the mailbox outside Mattson Centre.

Vending machines

There are vending machines on the main floor of each residence building. Should a monetary loss occur, please notify the Conference Centre Office, Fraser Hall.
